Metzeler Racetec TD Slicks from £310

'Perfect for an enthusiastic trackday rider's needs'

Tested by Jon Urry for one track day / 250 miles

As I prefer to change tyres rather than bodywork, I fit slicks to my trackday CBR600RR.

Providing way more grip than my CBR or my own bravado can exploit, I have been a convert to slicks for a while.

Previously I'd used Metzeler's Racetec CompK, however when they needed changing I opted for their successor, the TD Slick. Like CompKs, the TDs are aimed at enthusiastic trackday riders and don't require tyre warmers (I use them anyway), can withstand a greater number of heat cycles than a pure race slick and have a construction and sizing more akin to road tyres, meaning you don't have to fiddle with suspension settings. You

don't get options on compounds but who cares about that?

And the wear rate is impressive, after my experiences with the CompKs I'd be happy to run them on at least four, probably five, full trackdays on my lightweight 600. That's a tyre bill of about £60 a trackday – and hopefully no broken bodywork.
